**IBT INTERNATIONAL OFFICER ELECTION**  
**ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINAL BALLOT TABULATION**  
**RESULTS**

The Office of the Election Supervisor for the International Brotherhood of Teamsters completed the count of all ballots returned by members eligible to vote in the election of the Teamsters Union International Officers on November 18, 2011 in Alexandria, VA. 233,317 ballots were counted from members of 597 Local Unions in the United States and Canada. This report includes the number of challenged ballots logged in each of the officer contests. There is no need to resolve any of the challenged ballots because the margin of victory exceeds the number of challenged ballots in each contest. *Rules for the 2010-2011 IBT International Union Officer and Delegate Election*, Article IV, §9.
